The 16-day "Ancient Algeria and the Sahara Desert" is a comprehensive, two-week journey from the vibrant city of **Constantine** with its nearby ancient cities of Tipaza, Timgad and Djemila to the Algerian Sahara. Travelers will skirt the **Mediterranean** coastline taking in views of the Islamic architecture and ancient rock paintings of Algiers and spend nights camping under a star-filled sky.
