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Woodstock

In Woodstock, [one of the most beautiful towns in the U.S.](#) (think: picture-book New England foliage complete with a cute town green), you can be up and down 1,250-foot Mount Tom in about 90 minutes.

Stay at grand dame [Woodstock Inn & Resort](#), which is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year. Visit the property's Kelly Way Gardens a mile away—it's home to organic produce and also a 135-foot 'gourdwalk' trellis covered in 17 different kinds of gourds and vines. Back at the hotel, you'll be greeted with a roaring oversized fire in the lobby.
